[PROPOSED] ORDER

Before the Court is the parties' Joint Motion to Stay Proceedings. Having considered the motion, the Court finds the motion well taken.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the parties' Joint Motion to Stay Proceedings is **GRANTED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this action is **STAYED** in all respects for ninety (90) days from the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the initial pretrial conference set for September 29, 2026, is **VACATED**, and that the case-management deadlines proposed in the parties' Joint Report of the Rule 26(f) Conference, ECF No. 15, are held in abeyance during the stay. If this action is not resolved during the stay, the parties shall confer and submit proposed scheduling recommendations within fourteen days after the stay expires.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the preliminary injunction entered on August 4, 2026, ECF No. 16, remains in full force and effect during the stay.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall file a joint status report within forty-five (45) days of the date of this Order and shall promptly notify the Court upon finalization of the settlement.
